The U.S. Chamber of Commerce had been looking for a better way to disseminate information regarding emergency procedures and how to evacuate the building in an emergency. We have used fire drills, and will continue to do so, but felt that given the infrequency of the drills, we wanted to be able to provide evacuation information to new employees and others when an evacuation drill wasn't possible.

The Chamber became aware of Stadium Evac after watching an animated video of an evacuation from a sports venue. We contacted Steve Whiting to see if he would be interested in working on our project. Although his company had previously produced videos only for stadiums, he was confident that he could adapt their processes to work in a commercial building.
